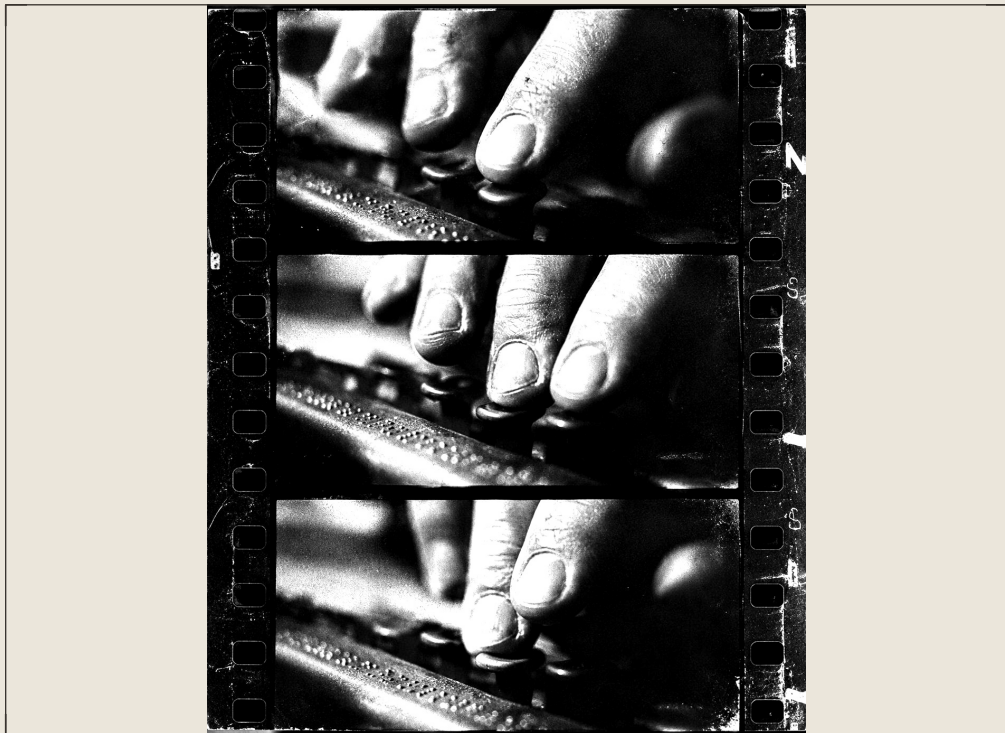

we live in darkness twice.

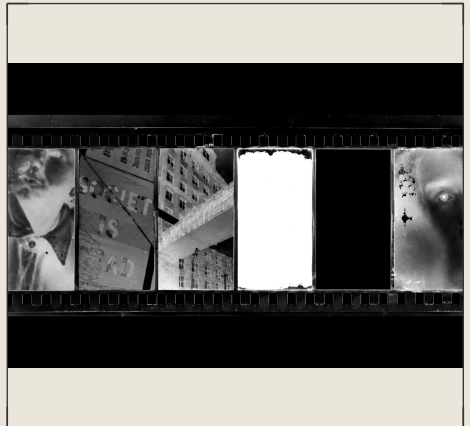
They trained us

different while staying the same.

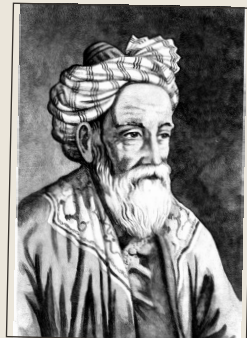
This is a signal.

Malcolm would tell you:

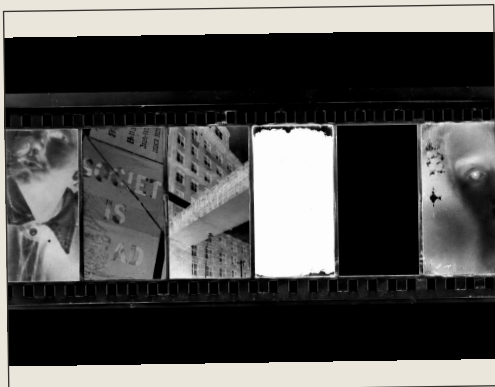
you've been had. bamboozled.

FIELD REPORT: SIARGAO, PHILIPPINES

12 May 2026 / General Luna, Surigao del Norte

CONFIRMED

The Cartoon Cafe, General Luna, displayed a Palestinian flag.

LGU General Luna confirmed two individuals attacked the owners on 12 May 2026.

Owners sustained injuries. CCTV was destroyed. Windows were smashed.

Mayor Johnson Y. Sajulga condemned the attack. Investigation ongoing.

REPORTED

Suspects reported to be Israeli nationals.

Attack reported to have occurred at 4am while owners slept. Baby present.

Attackers reported to have used a wooden plank with nails.

Video of Israeli national removing Palestinian and Philippine flags from local businesses – circulated, then deleted.

UNANSWERED

Why did the ambassador meet privately with the mayor the day before the attack?
Why did she not attend the community meeting? Why was the chat disabled?
Were the suspects identified, arrested, or charged?

TIMELINE

11 May:
Ambassador Dana Kursh and Consul Moti Cohen meet Mayor Sajulga. Closed-door. No community.

12 May:
Cartoon Cafe attacked. 4am.

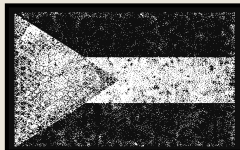
13 May:
Community town hall convened. Dana Kursh: absent. No notice given.

13 May (online session):
Chat disabled.
